## 40 DAYS - 40 ITEMS

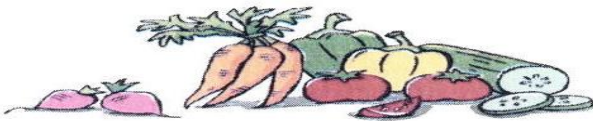
Instead of giving up something for Lent this year, why not try the **40 days - 40 items challenge**?
